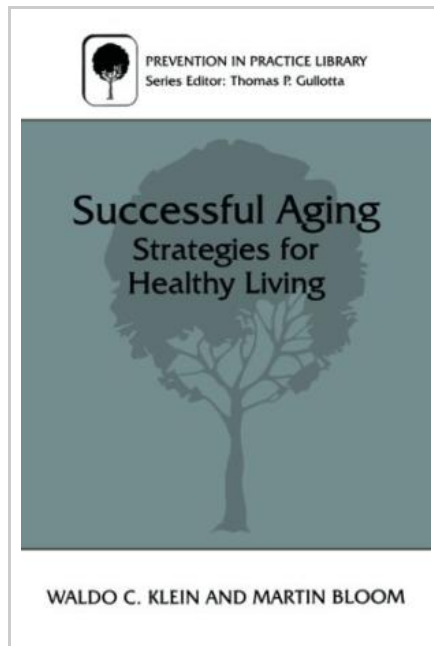




Successful Aging: Strategies for Healthy Living
